Duties:

Pack Meeting: Arrive at the Knights Hall at least 45 minutes before the Pack Meeting to help set up. Scouts in the den(s) assigned will hold doors, pass out programs, answer questions, and otherwise welcome families to the event. Parents in the den(s) assigned will assist pack leaders as needed. Den(s) assigned will also do the opening and closing flag ceremonies. Everyone to help clean up the hall after the meeting.

Marywood Bingo: At least one family will need to arrive by 6:45 PM to help carry in the “prizes” to the room where the bingo game is held. Parents can take turns helping call bingo numbers and the Scouts help the residents by reading their cards when a bingo is called and retrieving their selected prize.

Knights' Breakfast: Arrive slightly before or immediately after *the end of* 9:30 AM Mass at All Saints. Scouts will bus tables (i.e. throw away guests’ paper plates and such) and help guests as needed. Parents to monitor Scouts and provide guidance as needed.

Class A = Blue uniform shirt with insignia attached and appropriate color neckerchief.
(or “Field Uniform”) Should also include belt and hat. Can wear shorts or long pants as appropriate.
(Recommend wearing a t-shirt underneath so Class A uniform shirt may be removed as needed.)
(Webelos may opt to wear the tan Boy Scout uniform shirt and green shorts/pants.)

Class B = Any Pack 1188 t-shirt with gym shorts or sweat pants as appropriate. May wear hat if desired.
(or “Activity Uniform”) (If no Pack 1188 t-shirt is available, an appropriate blue or yellow t-shirt is fine.)
